The 2019 tournament, and the Espresso Division, was won in a dramatic photo finish by Glen Ryan, who also won in 2018. Chris Adams took second place and Jon Delfin took third. Cappuccino Division winners were Corey Booth in first, Brandon Lomuto in second, and Suzie Spaulding in third.
